### Chevron Statement

The following is a statement from Chevron Malaysia Limited in response to the recent meeting between the Company, certain affected ex-retailers and the Ministry of Domestic Trade, Cooperatives and Consumerism (KPDNKK):

Chevron Malaysia is aware of the statements, most of which are false, inflammatory and misleading, made by a third party towards the Ministry of Domestic Trade, Cooperatives and Consumerism (KPDNKK) and the Company.

Chevron appreciates the assistance of the KPDNKK with the support given by the Secretary General (KSU) as a neutral party to resolve this issue.

The recent termination of six retailers is a business decision, and is carried out in accordance with the contractual agreement between the parties. These retailers were granted a dealership to operate Caltex stations owned by Chevron Malaysia. Any dispute by these affected retailers over the termination should be channelled through the right legal avenues, in accordance with the country's laws.

To all our customers, we would like to inform you that our Caltex stations will continue to serve you as usual! We thank you for your support.
